Later this spring (late April or early May, date TBD), we're planning a church work day/ spring cleaning day on a Saturday. We'll have all sorts of small projects to work on, and we'll provide lunch for all that can come and volunteer some time to help out. Stay tuned for details!

Financials & Facilities Updates

Two significant items headline this section. First, we are under contract to sell a lot of land adjacent to the back portion of our church property. This sale is helping us fund a new roof for the church building. The land sale is due to be finalized at the end of March, and the roof work is tentatively scheduled for early May.

Our budget for 2023 includes corporate giving: financial support for individuals and organizations that are meeting spiritual and physical needs both locally and globally. This was an "in faith" addition to the budget, meaning that it pushed our planned spending beyond what we received in tithes and offerings in 2022. Through February, giving is on pace to be at 85% of our budget. Please pray that God will meet the financial needs of our church, and also that He'll provide wisdom in how we spend those gifts and who we partner with in ministry.

Community Outreach Opportunity: Come Spring Food Pantry

As we seek to be faithful in following Jesus in His work to transform our local and global community by showing compassion and love for those at the margins, we wanted to follow up with some opportunities available for <u>YOU</u> as we come alongside local partners to build, engage, and serve. As a reminder, one of the organizations we are partnering with is Come Spring Food Pantry in Union, which serves Western Knox County. There are a combination of recurring needs and upcoming projects/requests below. Please connect with Aaron or Kristie Kosalski (ministry contact later in this newsletter) for more details!

Recurring needs:

- Food pantry staffing: check in and help recipients, help with stocking, etc. Training provided!
 - Wednesdays: Need 1-2 more folks to staff the pantry on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month from 10am-1pm
 - Saturdays: Need 3-5 more folks to staff the pantry on the 1st Saturday of the month starting May 6th from 10am-1pm

Upcoming Projects:

- Gardening and construction: we will need folks willing to be part of our gardening and construction projects in spring and summer (dates TBD)
 - Construction: Converting existing bathroom to an ADA bathroom and the walls will need to come out. We have a master plumber and building manager as well, we just need a crew.
 - Gardening: We have a lead for the garden projects but we will need a crew to help build raised beds, put them in and plant them. Also need someone to maintain the mowing during the summer as well.

Food Requests:

 Here are a list of some items that go quickly and are consistent needs: Canned Tuna & Canned Chicken, Baked Beans, Jam or Jelly, Cereal, Salad Dressing, Coffee, Tea, Mayonnaise, BBQ Sauce, Condensed Milk, Dish Soap, Laundry Detergent, Toilet Paper, Tissues, Dog Food & Cat Food, and Resealable Plastic Bags.
